- The future of stroke services in N. Devon remains uncertain
 - 1 in 6 beds across Devon could close
- Emergency services (A&E) could be greatly reduced

This informal meeting will be hosted by two Combe Martin residents who support Save Our Hospital Services Devon, an open, broad-based, non-aligned group that has come together with the single aim of campaigning against the proposed cuts to our local hospital and healthcare services.
